Challenges

- Remote rural border regions with less economic opportunities.
- Lack of proper regional territorial planning and governance for persons with disabilities, awareness about their needs.
- Lack of accessible tourism, services and standardised data for persons with disabilities.

Project objectives

- To improve **governance, better territorial planning and cooperation of multi-level cross-sectoral stakeholders.**
- Participatory and capacity raising process, connecting persons with disabilities, public authorities and tourism stakeholders.
- Big potential for the **implementation of accessible tourism** for persons with disabilities and to improve **employability and development** in transborder areas.
- Better **quality of life** for persons with disabilities (mobility, employment, social inclusion).

Main outputs and solutions

- 1 Web accessibility viewer for accessible tourism.
- 2 Pilot actions to jointly develop and test solutions and services for independent and safe travel of people on wheelchairs and blind and visually impaired in 3 pilot regions.
- 3 Joint strategy on territorial planning for accessible tourism.
- 4 Action plans for improving accessibility of tourism in the transborder tourism regions.

Cooperation

- Involvement of persons with disabilities** is essential for project objectives and goals.
- Exchange of knowledge, practices and participatory co-development of solutions.
- Common approach for collecting data** will improve governance for accessible tourism, territorial tourism strategies, develop services for persons with disabilities, capacity building and policy integration.
